- B. Permit Application 56-21-303/308/310, Tim Glover. The Board reviewed the request for permit in conjunction for irrigation for total of 80 AF annually. The three wells will be permitted in conjunction. A motion was made by Gay and seconded by Shawn to approve the applications, permitting 56-21-303/308/310 in conjunction for 80 AF for irrigation annually. Motion passed

Report on District Activities: Angelina presented the District Activities Report (report attached).

Manager's Report: David said that he anticipates that the rule of capture, as well as other groundwater topics, will be addressed during the next legislative sessions.

New Business:

- A. The Board reviewed and discussed possible action on public comment for DFCs. No public comment.
- B. The Board reviewed and discussed purchasing two aquifer models and carrying cases, one for the office and one for the San Saba County Historical Museum. Bill suggested buying one to see what it looks like first then purchasing one for the office later. Gay and Angelina then discussed buying another one later

for the Mason County Library. A motion was made to buy one model for the San Saba County Historical Museum by Bill and seconded Gay. Motion passed.

- C. The Board reviewed and discussed possible action on promoting Angelina to Co-Manager. A motion was made to promote Angelina to Co-Manager with all the authority and responsibility as the General Manger by Gay and seconded by Shawn. Motion passed
